During your studies in Year 10 & 11, it is of increasing importance that all students develop the habits and skills of independent learning and revision which will support you through your mock examinations and through to the final examinations in Years 11 and 13. LCHS subscribes, at a significant cost, to a variety of online resources to support you during these important years. Your final exam grades will reflect the work you place into your studies. During the first term, I posted updated exam board details as an announcement within ClassCharts and on our school website, the following information should serve as a reminder of how to access these important resources.

**Seneca** – This provides key content and tests students on a range of subjects and topics.

Click on Login, then click on 'Continue with Microsoft' to access using your school log in details.

Password – the password used to log on to computers in school

Scroll down, select GCSE and then choose the correct exam board and course, finally choose your topics

You chose your own username and password. Click on Login as a student.

If you haven't logged in before, click 'I'm new to GCSEPod'

Enter your full name and date of birth.

Click on search for your school and start typing in 'Lincoln Christ' – it will bring up a drop down list of schools.

Select our school, if it doesn't appear check that you are using the full name that school has for you. E.g. Samuel not Sam, Jennifer not Jenny etc.

If you have forgotten your login details,

In Student Login

Click on 'Forgotten my login details' and either enter your recovery email or type your name, date of birth etc. into the search box.

**Kerboodle** - If you have logged on previously, type your details into the following page

e.g. Joseph Smith would have jsmith etc. Your password is the same as your username unless you have changed it!

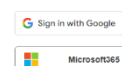
